Visitor Safety at the Pasco Aviation Museum

Welcome to the Pasco Aviation Museum. Located in the historic Naval Air Station Pasco Control Tower building, the main entrance, ground floor and restrooms are ADA compliant and fully accessible. The 2nd floor and control tower access is by guided tours only. The architectural and historic nature of the 1942 building prevents an elevator from being installed. The only way to go up inside the NAS Pasco Control Tower is to climb steps. Virtual tours will be available and future plans hope to include a lift or elevator if possible.

For visitors under the age of 18, a parent, legal guardian or designated adult must accompany minors on the tour.

The following items are **ALLOWED** on the Museum Tour:

- Electronic devices such as: cellphones, smart phones, ipads, etc
- Recording equipment (audio, video, and data)
- Cameras (still, motion-picture, video)

The following items are **prohibited**:

- Cigarettes, cigars, e-cigarettes, any vaping devices. Smoking is prohibited in all areas of the museum and on airport grounds.
- Any weapons and ammunition
- Explosives or incendiary devices
- Controlled substances (e.g., marijuana, illegal drugs and associated paraphernalia)
Note: Prescription drugs in their original containers are not prohibited
- Alcoholic beverages
- Any items prohibited by law
- Pets/animals (except service/support animals)
